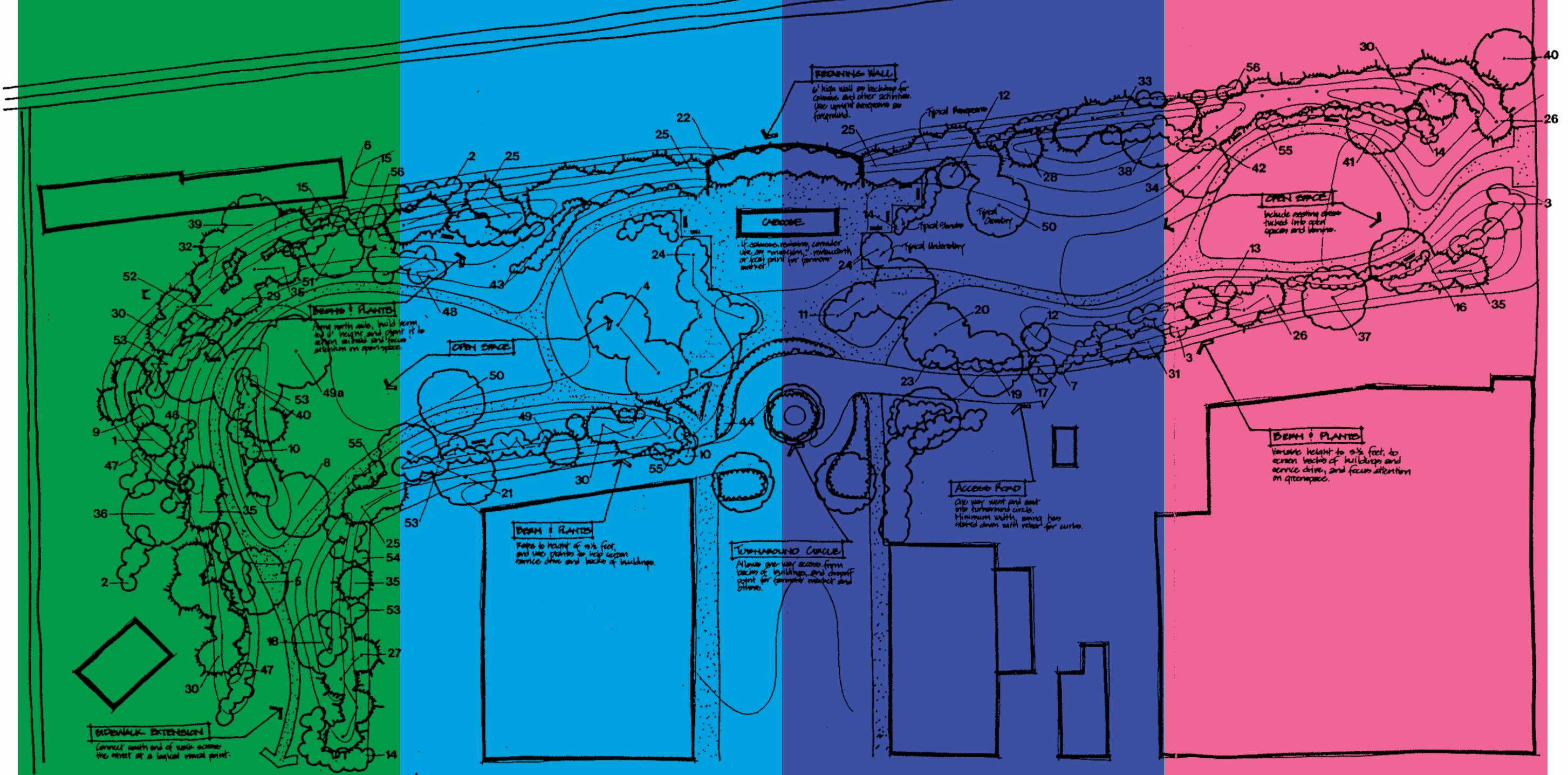

1. **CANOPIE**
If canopy remains, work it into the rehabilitation design by creating more structure in pavement and plant materials.
2. **SEATING**
Tuck seating into slightly raised areas with a protective thickness of plant material. Place benches at right angles in areas where conversation is desirable, and all benches should be on a raised surface.
3. **STREET AND ACCESS**
Build turnaround on corner into path space, allowing particular entrance and way out from either direction.
4. **WALKS**
Use existing natural paths in a loop design to allow flexibility of use.
5. **PLANTING**
Use primarily hardy native species, planted to avoid harshness. Limit individual specimens and introduce materials. More plants better appropriate.
6. **BEAM & PLANTED**
Use slopes of 3% or less varying heights and varied uses of slopes into surrounding spaces. Because of driveway's flat surface, heavy soils needed and resistant, prepared grades before construction settlement.
